Diving Into Learning



Reading:

After Thanksgiving break, readers will be focused on reading for information. We will also continue to use text features to make meaning while reading. Nonfiction text is everywhere! *Help your child find informational text at the local library!*

Writing:

We have survived our first book publishing. The students feel pretty proud of their stories. After the holiday, we will be planning and drafting our nonfiction books. Students are allowed to write on any informational topic (except biographies or how-to-books, which will come later in our next 2 writing units). *Ask your child to tell you about the parts that make up a nonfiction book. Help them chose an interesting topic to research!*

Math:

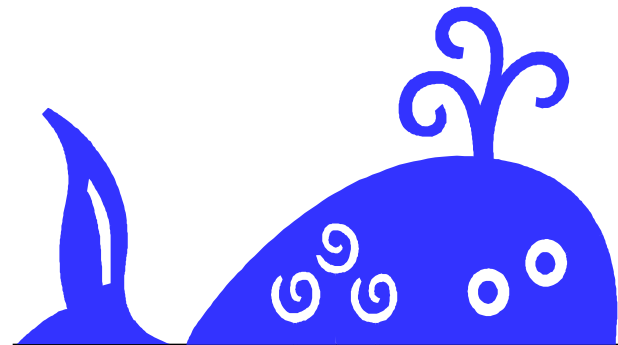

As we continue critical thinking when solving word problems, we practice **visualizing** word problems and **identifying clue words** for solving real-world applications. *Encourage him/her to write word problems to stump Mrs. Coats! 😊.*

Over the next few weeks, we will be studying geographic locations using maps to learn about our world. *Make a map of a familiar location such as a bedroom, house or neighborhood with your child. Use the elements found on map such as a title, compass, legend and scale! Make it more fun with a treasure map! Play a game to find Mrs. Baugh.*

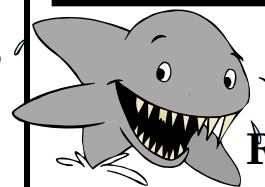

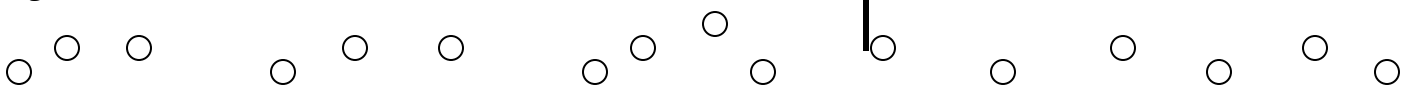

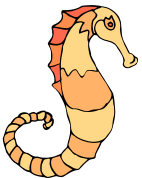
