

Military Family Life Consultant Program

The Military Family Life Consultant Program is a service, through the Department of Defense, that is being provided to Sigsbee Charter School. A Licensed professional is available to provide non-medical, brief, problem-oriented resolution counseling and support services to service members, their families, parents, and staff of Sigsbee Charter School.

The service is **Strictly Confidential** and requires no personal identifying information (PII). **No records** or identifying documents are kept. In addition, there is **no charge** for these professional and confidential services.

The services that are available are:

- Observe, participate, and engage in activities with the children in and out of the classroom
- Provide brief solution-oriented counseling to assist children to resolve challenges that arise at school or at home
- Facilitate children's adjustment to parental deployment
- Conduct trainings for staff, parents, and students
- Recommend referral for military social services and other local resources as needed
- Participate in field trips as needed
- Consult with teachers and staff as needed
