

## Committees

Charter School Committees are appointed by the Charter Board President, with the approval of the Charter Board of Directors. These committees carry out the important functions of the Corporation. The Charter Board President and the Principal are standing members of all committees. Participation from other members of the school community is essential for the successful growth of the school. Corporation members (parents and guardians of Charter School students) are welcome to choose a committee on which to serve. The following committees are currently active:

### **Facilities: (Chairperson: Sandy Higgs)**

This committee oversees the maintenance and future growth of the facility. It is responsible for developing proposals for renovations, upkeep and volunteer labor events. The facilities committee also arranges gatherings for school beautification projects and reaches out to the greater community for assistance and donations related to structural and landscaping projects.

### **Fundraising: (Chairperson: SFA Representative)**

Charter Schools rely heavily on funding that comes from the school's community efforts. The SCS fundraising committee works to create exciting events that lead to increase revenue for the school. These efforts provide engaging activities for students while increasing our ability to provide students with needed resources, materials and activities.

### **Lunch: (Chairpersons: Bob Eadie/Colleen Tabberer)**

This committee creates and maintains the lunch program at the school. Members assist in soliciting vendors, recruiting volunteers to help during lunch hours and collaborating to create healthy and affordable meal options for students. The lunch committee ensures that all food programs meet the appropriate health standards and encourage healthy eating habits for our school family. A long-term goal for the lunch committee is the gradual transition to nutritious, balanced, organic meals for students and the adoption of a Free or Reduced Lunch Program.

### **Student Family Alliance (SFA) (Chairpersons: Michelle Hagge/Leslie Crabbs)**

SFA connects all stakeholders in organizing special events for our school community. Many of these events, such as the Fall Festival, also raise funds for special programs at the school. Other planned activities, such as Teacher Appreciation Events, celebrate important members of the school community. SFA members meet monthly in the library (the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month at 5:30 PM).
